Stripes n' Dots

Download and save file to your desktop. Print files all at once, or you can print single pages by selecting "file>print this page." Turn off any page scaling and print files at 100%. Print on heavy card stock. Using a cutting mat, ruler, and blade, lightly score along fold lines first. Fold lines are illustrated on the left diagram and are indicated by guides on the right diagram and on your printout. Next, use your ruler and blade (or scissors) to cut around perimeter of box.

Carefully and thoroughly fold all box sides and tabs. It is helpful at this point to put your box together without gluing to get a feel for what it will look like, where you will need to glue, and if you need to score or fold better. Now, apply glue or double-sided tape to the tabs indicated. You do not want to put glue on the tabs that are on the top flap and on the sides of the box opening. Press your glued tabs to the corresponding box sides. Let 'er dry.
